Huntington's Disease:

Huntington's Disease (HD) is a hereditary brain disorder, which slowly robs the effected individual of their ability to walk, talk, and reason. Symptoms progress slowly over a 10 – 15 year period. HD typically occurs in mid-life, between the ages of 30 – 45, after an individual has established a career, married and had children while very possibly having passed the defective gene on to these children. HD is known as a family disease because of its genetic nature and its dramatic impact on every family member. Currently, over 30,000 Americans, including 3,000 children between the ages of six months and 18 years, have been diagnosed with Huntington's Disease. Since HD is hereditary, there are another 200,000 people who are classified as being at risk of having inherited the disease. Children of those affected by HD have a 50% chance of inheriting their parent's devastating disease.
